#### Introduction


- The first time when Hungarian prosecutors and policemen, under the support of the Office of the Prosecutor General of Hungary have joined such a form of international cooperation in criminal matters as JIT
- Investigation upon the crime report filed in by the Hungarian Football Association against unknown perpetrator for the criminal case of bribery
- The Central Investigative Chief Prosecutor's Office (CICPO) is conducting the investigation in cooperation with the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI)
- The case is currently investigated for the felony of fraud as an organized crime and the felony of bribery with the purpose of international football betting fraud
- The Hungarian investigation authority has also carried out investigative acts in JIT member countries (Finland and Germany) and provided and received information in a rogatory letter inter alia from Italy, Croatia, Macedonia, the Isle of Man, Alderney and the Philippines.

## The first investigative actions

- CICPO and NIB took a coordinated, large-scale action on the 28<sup>th</sup> of June 2011
- Simultaneous-house searches on 12 scenes:
  - Large amount of physical and documentary evidence
  - Electronic data storage media
  - Large sum of money (EUR 320,000)
  - 7 persons arrested (3 football players and 4 referees)
  - on the day of the arrest all interrogated as suspects of multiple-count, organized, businesslike and cumulative fraud and bribery



#### The method of the criminal organization



- **Tasks** of the Hungarian members and their helpers around matches selected and approved by the head of the syndicate:
  - organize the bribery of players and/or referees
  - arrange travel to the selected matches
  - pass the bribery money given by the head of the syndicate
  - inform the head about the accomplishment of the tasks entrusted regarding the manipulation of the match
- Successful manipulation: Gained net profits were equally distributed among all the members of the "syndicate" (including those who did not "work" on the particular match)
- Unsuccessful manipulation: expenses were borne by the organization as a whole

### Investigation facts 1

- In the case presently there are 50 persons former and active players, referees, club owners, football managers and trainers suspected with regard of 33 matches
- The matches include:

Matches manipulated by the criminal organization on an international level with the participation of the Hungarian members	<ul> <li>1 Italian first division championship match</li> <li>3 Finnish first division matches</li> <li>1 international match</li> <li>2 international junior team matches</li> </ul>
Matches manipulated by the criminal organization on a <b>Hungarian</b> level	<ul> <li>2 friendly international club matches</li> <li>11 Hungarian championship matches</li> <li>2 Hungarian cup matches</li> <li>5 Hungarian league cup matches</li> <li>1 Hungarian second division match</li> <li>4 Hungarian U-19 matches</li> <li>1 Hungarian regional first division match</li> </ul>



## Investigation facts 2

#### Money:

- Money spent on manipulating players and/or referees: EUR 40,000-600,000 per match
- Damages caused to football bookmakers: EUR 200,000-2,000,000
   by each successfully manipulated match

#### **Criminals (present situation):**

- 3 suspects held in pre-trial detention
- 1 suspect under the confinement to the place of residence
- others are not placed under any coercive measures

Our investigation is expected to be completed by the end of February 2013.
